Nature and effects of the request:

The request for a minor exemption is to be able to reduce the front setback to within 25 metres of the street, i.e. 21.51 metres, and the rear setback to 16.43 metres.

Identification of the site concerned:

The site to which this application relates is located on lot 5 192 9905 of the cadastre of Québec (registration number 8908-66-4148) located at 12 Paige Road in West Bolton in zone RES-1.

ROADS AND INFRASTRUCTURE TOWN HALL – VENTILATION AND AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEM

PUBLIC SECURITY CANADIAN RED CROSS SOCIETY – DISASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT

WHEREAS municipalities must take measures to ensure the protection of the life, health, and integrity of persons and property in the event of disasters, per several legislative texts, including the Civil Protection Act (C.Q.L.R., c.S-2.3) and the Municipal Code of Québec (R.L.R.Q., c.C-27.1);

WHEREAS the Canadian Red Cross Society is a not-for-profit humanitarian organization, and a full member of the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement, whose mission includes assisting individuals, groups, or communities affected by emergencies or disasters;

WHEREAS the Canadian Red Cross Society, through its resources, including a volunteer force, and its expertise, is likely to assist and support cities and



No de résolution ou annotation municipalities as an auxiliary of public authorities in the event of disasters, subject to the availability of its human and material resources;

WHEREAS the Canadian Red Cross Society is recognized by the Quebec Ministry of Public Security for: (i) preparing and implementing services to disaster victims; and (ii) managing the inventory of emergency equipment owned by the Government of Quebec and available in the event of a Disaster;

WHEREAS the Parties wish to establish the terms and conditions under which the Canadian Red Cross Society will provide Services to Disaster Victims in the event of Disasters within the Town/Municipality;

WHEREAS, pursuant to paragraph 2.1 of the first paragraph of Section 938 of the Municipal Code of Québec, this Agreement is not subject to the tendering rules set out in Sections 935 and 936 of the same Act.
