

CONCERNING THE THIRD YEAR OF THE THREE-YEAR PROPERTY ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST BOLTON FOR THE YEARS 2024-2025-2026

Notice is hereby given that the triennial property assessment roll of the Municipality of West Bolton will, in 2026, be in effect for its third fiscal year, and that any person may examine it during regular business hours at the office of said Municipality, located at 9 Town Hall Road, West Bolton.

In accordance with the provisions of section 74 of the *Act respecting municipal taxation*, notice is also given that any person having an interest in contesting the accuracy, presence or absence of an entry on this roll, in respect of a property owned by himself or another person, may file an application for review in this regard, in accordance with Section I of Chapter X of this Act.

To be admissible, such a request for revision must meet the following conditions:

- Be filed during the fiscal year in which an event occurs justifying a modification of the roll under the law, or during the following fiscal year;
- Be made on the prescribed form available at <https://www.mrcbm.qc.ca/demande-de-revision> and at the Town Hall of the Municipality of West Bolton;
- Be submitted online form, by mail, or in person at the following address :
